Reviewer General Comments and Suggestions (mandatory written feedback):

The exercise described in the abstract sounds interesting as a brief experiment regarding perception, drawing, and modeling. What's not clear is a) how this exercise fits into the broader curricular goals of the program or the even the course, b) why the methods used in the exercise are more effective than other methods, and c) ultimately how the exercise relates to existing research on design pedagogy. Does the exercise help students to learn more effectively? What, specifically, are they learning? How is the effectiveness of the exercise being assessed – is it anecdotal or objective (i.e., measurable in some way)? Again, the exercise itself sounds interesting. But a paper about this topic should aspire to much more than a mere description of the exercise and some examples of student work – there should be context (curriculum and relevant pedagogical research) and some form of objective assessment of the results.
